# 33<sup>rd</sup> Annual NORTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA EMMY AWARDS

The 33<sup>rd</sup> Annual Northern California Area EMMY Awards were presented Saturday, May 22, 2004, at the Palace of Fine Arts in San Francisco. The EMMY honors excellence in all fields of television production.

The Best Newscast-Large Market went to **ABC 7 News at 11, KGO-TV,** San Francisco, and the Best Newscast-Large Market went to **ABC 7 News at 11, KGO-TV,** San Francisco, and the Best Newscast-Medium Market (new category) went to **Action News Live at 5, Fresno's KFSN ABC 30.** The Best Newscast Small Market went to **Action News Eight at 6pm, KSBW**, Salinas. **KRON 4**, San Francisco was awarded Emmy statues in 11 categories, followed by **KPIX CBS 5**, San Francisco and **KVIE 6**, Sacramento, with five. **KGO ABC 7**, San Francisco, **KNTV NBC 11**, San Jose and **Fox Sports Net** each had four.

**Jacqueline McLean**, KGMB 9, Honolulu took home three individual statues. KGO ABC 7's, **Wayne Freedman** continued his winning streak with another statue bring his total to 45.

For the first time a regional Emmy was given for commercial announcements going to "Sports Bar," Goodby Silverstein and Partners, San Francisco.

There were 56 EMMY awards in 52 categories. 144 individual statues were awarded during the ceremony.

The EMMY is awarded by the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences. San Francisco/Northern California is one of twenty chapters awarding regional EMMYs. Northern California is composed of television and cable stations from Visalia to the Oregon border and includes Hawaii and Reno. Entries were aired during the 2003 calendar year.

**Barbara Rodgers,** KPIX CBS 5, was awarded the Governors' Award for lifetime achievement. **John Catchings**, Catchings & Associates, was given the Governors' Citation for his television news career. Governors' Service Medallion was awarded to **John Murray**, JM Communications, for his service on the Board of Governors. A special tribute was given to **Faith Fancher**, the KTVU FOX 2 reporter who died of breast cancer last year.

Two \$3,000 scholarships were awarded to **Xiaoli Zhou**, (Production) and **Robert Harris** (videography). both students attend the University of California, Berkeley.

The event was hosted by morning news anchors **Frank Somerville**, KTVU FOX 2 and **Sydnie Kohara**, KPIX CBS 5. **Scott Singer** was the musical director with the **Project: Pimento** lounge band. The evening continued with a buffet dinner and dancing to the band, "**Full Motion**" at the Exploratorium
