KPIX'S "EYEWITNESS NEWS AT 10" AND KSEE'S "24 HOUR NEWS AT 11"
TAKE EMMYS FOR LARGE AND SMALL MARKET NEWSCASTS
AT THE NORTHERN CALIFORNIA AREA EMMY AWARDS.

The 26th Annual Northern California Area Emmy Awards presented by The National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences, were handed out at a black tie banquet, Saturday night May 10th at the Fashion Center in San Francisco.

KPIX, San Francisco, "Eyewitness News at 10" and KSEE, Fresno "24 Hour News at 11" took home the Emmy's for Large and Small Market Newscasts. KGO, San Francisco carried off the most trophies with 10; followed by KPIX, San Francisco 7; KXTV, Sacramento 6; KRON, San Francisco 4; and KCRA, Sacramento 3. KITV, Honolulu; KTEH, San Jose; MSNBC and SportsChannel Pacific each received 2. Single Emmy's went to KBHK, San Francisco; KCSM, San Mateo; KFVE, Honolulu; KGMB, Honolulu; KHNL, Honolulu; KJEO, Fresno; KNTV, San Jose; KPWB, Sacramento; KQED, San Francisco; KSEE, Fresno; and KTVU, Oakland.

Channel 7 Feature Reporter, Wayne Freedman, added 4 more statutes to his trophy room. Sacramento Composer, Bongo Bob Smith, and KGO Editor, James Sudweeks, each received 3. Taking home 2 Emmys each were Tim Hazen, Producer/Editor, KPIX, San Francisco; Darrell Holdway, Editor and Elissa Rubin, Producer, KGO, San Francisco; Dee Watt, Freelance Producer/Editor; and Zachary Whitnack, Producer/Engineer, KXTV.

The Emmy's were presented for entries which were broadcast or cablecast during the calendar year of 1996 in Northern California, Reno and Hawaii. 516 entries were received, and judged by peer panels at sister chapters of the Academy in Chicago, Philadelphia and Seattle. The Awards Committee selected the 159 nominees and the 49 recipients by a blind scoring process. They looked at the judges scores for each category and selected a cut off point for nominee and recipient not knowing what the category or entries. A total of 104 Emmy statues were given to individuals.

The Academy also handed out three \$2,000.00 scholarships to local college students. Patrick J. Roche, College of San Mateo for Production. Kevin Christopher Wheeler, San Jose State University for Videography and Joseph G. Blea, College of San Mateo the KDTV Exito Escolar.
