2. Submissions may be emailed to Editor Kevin Wing at kevin@emmysf.com. Deadline for all submissions is the 24th of each month. This License and Release should be filled out, signed and also emailed to Kevin Wing by the 24th of each month.
3. The Submissions are intended to be published and distributed to both members of the National Academy of Television Arts & Sciences ("Members"), as well as the general public. In the event that you would like one or more of your Submissions to be limited to distribution only to Members, please clearly indicate this when submitting the Submission to NATAS by stating "FOR MEMBERS ONLY" at the top of the first page of the submission, above the copy that would appear in print. If indicated by you, NATAS will take reasonable steps to limit distribution to Members only. The foregoing notwithstanding, NATAS cannot guarantee or warrant that a Submission limited to distribution to Members only will not be made available to the general public by a third party or through any inadvertent or accidental act of NATAS.
