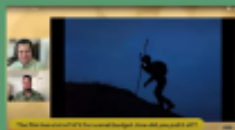

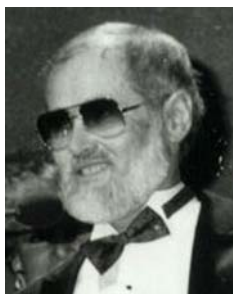

Vern Glenn is the Sports Director at KPIX 5. He joined KPIX 5/KBCWTV 44 Cable 12 in June of 2012 as week-end Sports Anchor/weekday sports reporter & MMJ. Since 2012, Vern has picked up five Emmy® Awards in the last six years for Best Sports-caster. In October 2020, Vern was inducted into the SF/NorCal *Silver Circle* Hall of Fame.

Vern had previously been at KRON 4 News since 1990. While at KRON, Vern was tagged with the nickname "Mr. Involvement" for literally throwing

himself in the middle of his feature stories. His memorable stories include bungee jumping, sky diving, bull riding, boxing, pro football and a dirt bike crash. Among his personal assignments was reporting from the 2000 Summer Olympic Games in Sydney, Australia.

From a shoot-out with Chris Mullin to becoming a human target playing for the Cal football team and the 49ers, "Mr. Involvement" has created a niche in the market. Vern brings that same type of energy to the KPIX news set. John Marvel, then of the Contra Costa Times wrote, "Mr. Involvement series is the best feature on TV."

Vern was part of the KNBR Radio Morning show in 1998 and drops in now and then as a guest on 95.7 The Game.

Vern also worked at WBAL-TV in Baltimore, Maryland, as weekend sports anchor and sports reporter from 1987 to 1990. Prior, he was sports anchor, sports reporter and photographer for WXEX-TV, now WRIC, in Richmond, Virginia, from 1985 to 1987.

An Eagle Scout and a graduate of the University of Virginia, Vern lives in Marin with his wife Nicole and three sons.

Breaking news, feature reporting, and Vicki Liviakis all go hand-in-hand. A trained Journalist from the University of California at Berkeley where she also studied politics, Liviakis is always on the move. She's traveled the globe, hosting on-location from Hollywood to Hong Kong. The recipient of Emmys®, RNTDA awards among many others, she currently anchors the evening news at KRON4 and shoots, writes,

and produces news profiles as well as the Dine & Dish local food scene feature. A survivor of the massive East Bay Firestorm in 1991, Vicki has hosted fire safety programs and recently traveled to Maui and interviewed people affected by the devastating wildfire. Those of us who go back a while are aware of San Francisco's popular radio station KFRC. Liviakis was an anchor and news director in radio before heading into TV. After KFRC, Liviakis went on to host and report for a variety of local and national television programs including The West, produced at Sacramento station KCRA. She was a national correspondent and news magazine host for Fox, CBS and NBC. She anchored the Travel Update program syndicated on more than 100 TV stations in the U.S. and several other countries.

Gold Circle Class of 2023



For 52 years, Ron Acker edited news and specials for KTVU with passion and a flare. He retired from working full-time but still can't give it up. He now edits once a week from home and his mission to produce exceptional work continues. That includes daily news, special reports and investigative projects.

Acker's work has earned him numerous awards. An Emmy®, Peabody, and the American

Legion's Fourth Estate Award for Excellence in Journalism.

The Peabody came in 2009 for the Bart Shootings. The Fourth Estate Award in 2017 for an investigative report entitled "Mental Hospital Hell." The piece used hidden cameras to reveal deplorable conditions at the John George Psychiatric Hospital. Patients were recorded sleeping and eating on the floor, moaning and crying out for help.

Acker is known as a calming, experienced force with editing precision, able to effectively and cleanly weave together powerful pieces that enhance storytelling. He's considered a legend at KTVU – and in the television industry.

Jim Stimson's lifelong dedication to television began at UC Davis when he landed a spot at the campus radio station KDVS. That led to freelance work for NBC, ABC and the Associated Press. Then an internship evolved into a full-time job in the KCRA Newsroom. All of that while he was still in college.

Jim first focused on KCRA's radio side, but soon transitioned to TV, rising from writer to producer, then senior producer, executive producer

and, eventually, Assistant News Director. Altogether Jim would spend more than 47 years with KCRA.

Across five decades, Jim helped guide coverage of one major story after another – the Loma Prieta earthquake, the 1997 New Year's flood, the Scott Peterson verdict, the Paradise wildfire, and so much more. He oversaw investigations, special projects, and thousands of newscasts.

Jim's work also extended beyond Sacramento. He produced gubernatorial and U.S. Senate debates that were broadcast statewide and a town hall broadcast with President Clinton that included live audiences in Sacramento, San Francisco, Los Angeles and San Diego.

Jim Stimson is the recipient of nine Emmy® Awards in six different categories, including News Excellence. He was inducted into the NATAS *Silver Circle* in 2008 and honored with the NATAS Governors' Citation in 2001. Now retired, Jim remains active in the television community, through his support of scholarship and mentor programs as well as judging Emmy® Award entries.
